SBI Sanjeevani: Bringing Healthcare to Rural Communities

In collaboration with the SBI Foundation, our SBI Sanjeevani initiative has been a game-changer in delivering quality healthcare to remote and underserved regions. As a CSR Flagship Project of SBI Foundation, this initiative deploys four mobile medical vans, fully equipped with state-of-the-art multispecialty healthcare facilities, across the Rahuri, Nandurbar, Gadchiroli, and Thane.

Reaching 20 villages in each block, these vans ensure that rural populations receive essential medical services, screenings, and preventive care right at their doorstep. This initiative has truly lived up to its name—Sanjeevani, a lifeline for those with limited access to healthcare, significantly improving health outcomes in remote locations.



DMMFRC Upcoming Proposed Project –300-Bedded Cancer Hospital at Kakadi, Shirdi

To address the growing need for quality cancer care in Western Maharashtra, Dr. Mane Medical Foundation & Research Center is set to establish a 500-bed multispecialty hospital in Kakadi, Shirdi (Ahmednagar District Headquarters). This hospital will be strategically located near Shirdi International Airport, ensuring easy accessibility through well-connected road and rail networks. Designed to provide comprehensive cancer treatment and healthcare services, the facility will cater to rural and underserved populations, contributing to the Sustainable Development Goal (SDG-3) – Good Health and Well-being.

Equipped with modern medical infrastructure, the hospital will offer diagnostics, advanced treatments, and surgical interventions, ensuring patients receive world-class healthcare. The project includes the establishment of specialized cancer care services, high-end medical equipment, critical support facilities, and an extensive list of fixed assets required for seamless operations. Additionally, a well-trained workforce comprising medical, paramedical, and non-medical staff will be recruited to maintain high standards of patient care. The financial planning covers cost estimations, procurement of medical supplies, and revenue structuring to ensure the hospital's sustainability.

The hospital will be constructed on foundation-owned land spanning 8.77 hectares (21.9 acres) at Gut No. 318 in Kakadi Village, Shirdi, just 10 km from the Shirdi Temple. With its central location, advanced medical services, and commitment to bridging the healthcare gap in rural areas, this hospital will be a landmark project dedicated to providing accessible, high-quality cancer care for all.
